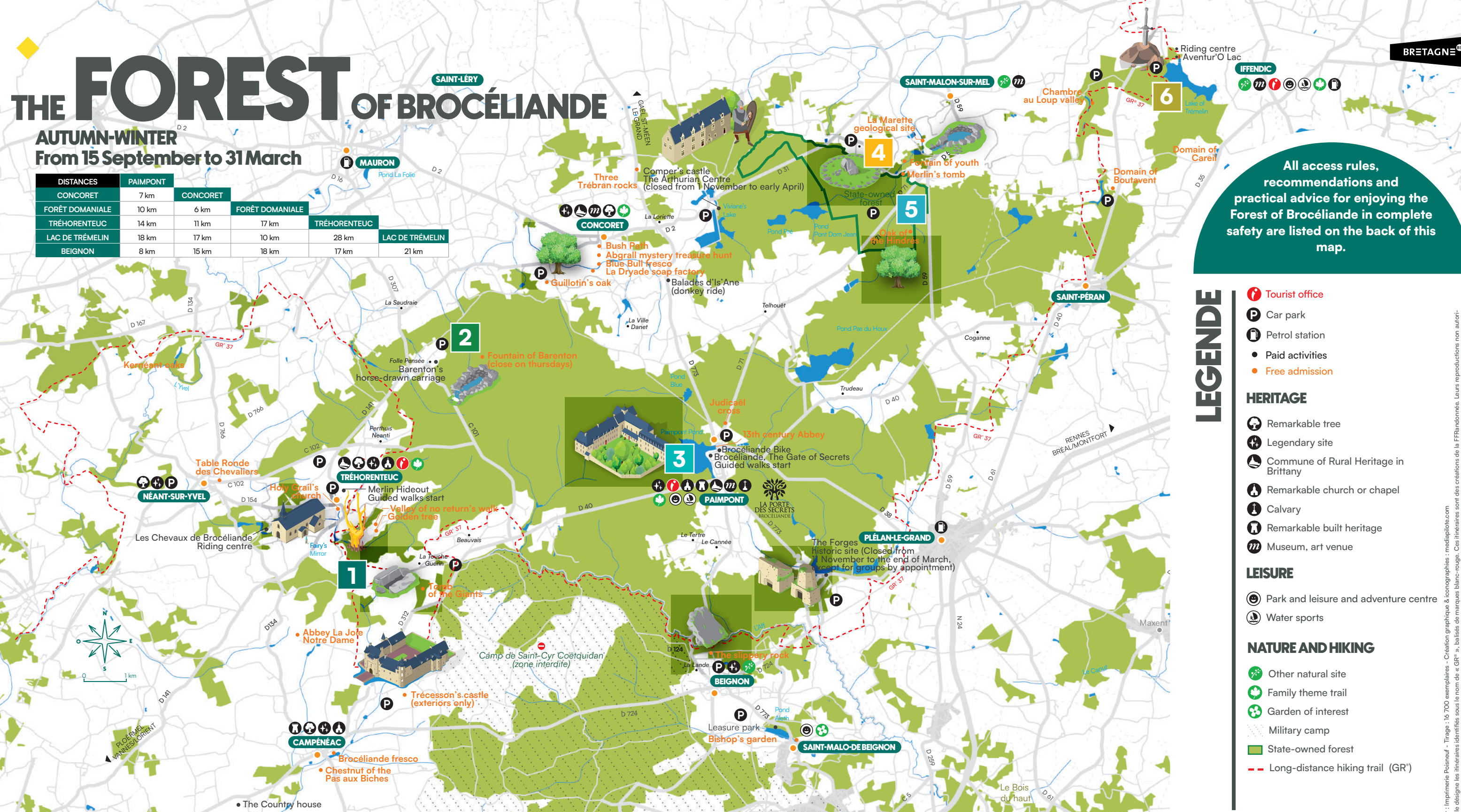

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THE FOREST OF BROCÉLIANDE

AUTUMN-WINTER

From 15 September to 31 March

The Paimpont Forest, also known as the Forest of Brocéliande, is privately owned and covers nearly 12,000 hectares. From 15 September to 31 March, access to the forest is restricted to allow for logging and to preserve its incredible biodiversity, which is recognised and protected. However, it is still possible to walk there and admire the beauty of Brocéliande, provided you respect the site and the rules that guarantee the balance of this exceptional natural heritage.

ADVICE & BEST PRACTICES



- Plan your route. The forest is vast and some sites require you to return to your vehicle.



- Please use the designated car parks so as not to obstruct forestry machinery or emergency vehicles.



- Stay on authorised paths, respect signage, fences and regulations in order to protect wildlife and natural environments.

- For younger children, opt for a baby carrier.



- Take your rubbish with you: many sites do not have bins.

Mushroom picking is permitted in the national forest except on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Limit your harvest to 5 litres (approximately 3kg) per person per day from 8am until sunset. Feel free to have your basket checked at a pharmacy. Commercial sale is prohibited.

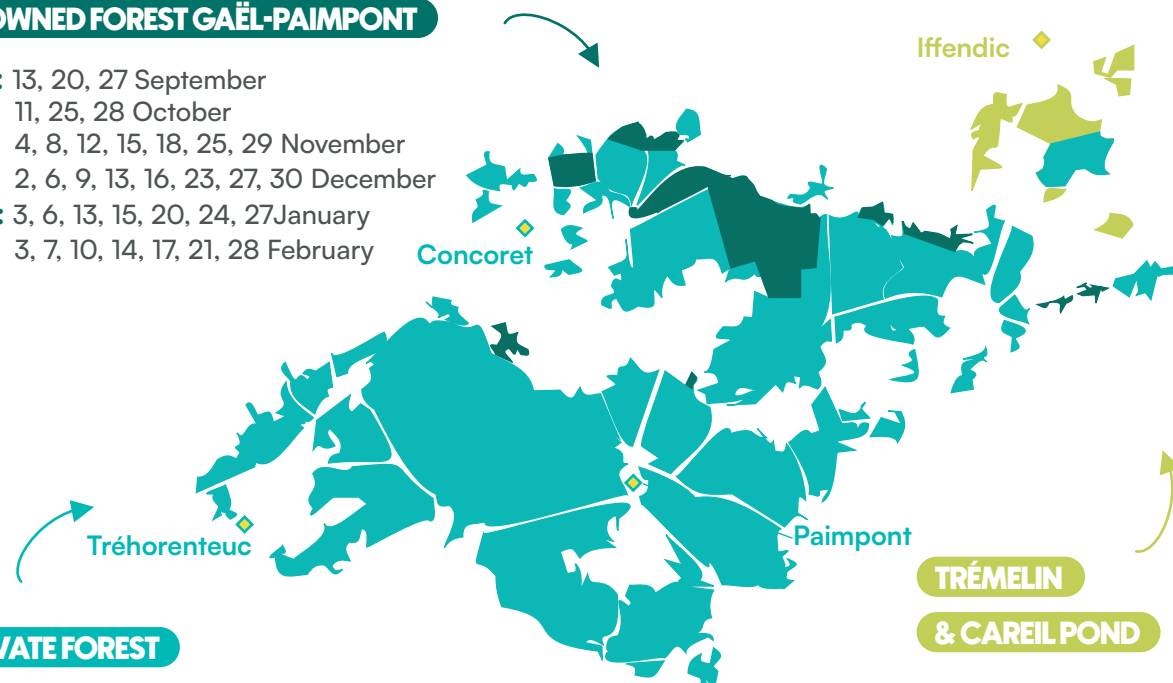


HUNTING INFORMATION

PRIVATE FOREST

Numerous hunting days are organised on private estates, but these are not subject to a regulated calendar. Therefore, be vigilant for hunting that may be in progress (signalled by hunters on the road).

13 December (Careil)
2026 : 10 January (Trémelin)
